Anna was handy inside and outside her home, mowing the lawn, cleaning the gutters, shoveling snow, painting the house and sewing her one-of-a-kind window treatments. Friends and family eagerly looked forward to her delicious homemade pizzelles and coveted the recipe which remains a mystery! Anna was a consummate volunteer. She was room mother, brownie leader, altar and rosary member, and enjoyed listening to family and friends, offering advice, prayers, and encouragement. Anna enjoyed many friendships

and gifted each with her love and understanding. Her unwavering love and support is the cornerstone of her family. Her wisdom, humor, and generosity left an indelible mark on all who knew her.

Celebrating Her Achievements

Anna was a pioneer in many ways. Uniquely skilled for several different professions, at age 47, she entered nursing school and graduated first in her class in academic and clinical achievement. She was the nurse that everyone wished they had. Kind, thorough, dedicated, compassionate and hard working. Early to work and late to leave, it was all about her patients, whomever and wherever they may be. This included hospital med-surg units, methadone clinics, prisons, and nurseries for babies born to drug addicted mothers. Anna was fearless and took on jobs and cases that no one else would do. She was strong physically, emotionally, and spiritually. She loved God and knew she was His child from a very early age. She pursued spiritual and metaphysical studies and practiced healthy eating and physical exercise before it was fashionable. Anna was always ahead of her time and right on time. She loved helping and educating others and many found solace in her bright smile and accepting demeanor. Anna brought joy and dedication to everything she did.

Anna is predeceased by her husband of fifty-five years, Mr. Fix-It and ballroom dancer, Daniel. Fellow dancers stopped and just watched Danny and Annie glide across the ballroom floor. Anna is survived by her children Roseann, Bill, Rhonda, Renee, Mario, Damian and Adriana and grandchildren Maria and Michael who will carry forward her lessons of love and perseverance. 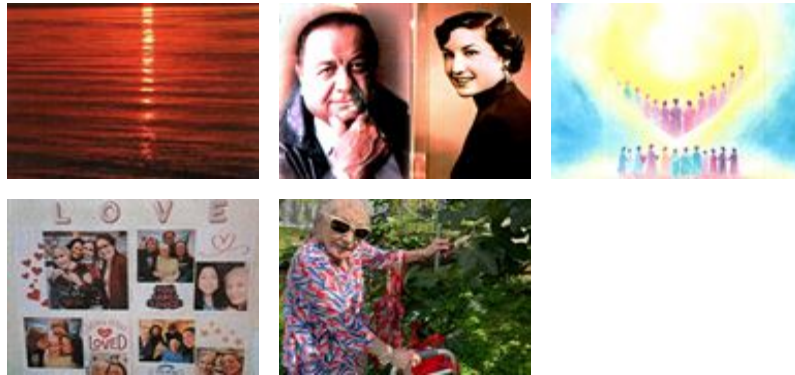
