Arlene Tripp Berge answered the last call on October 28, 2016, at Inspira Hospital in Woodbury, NJ, surrounded by her family. Raised in Westfield, NJ after her birth in 1932, she was the daughter of Louise Crouch Tripp and Jerome C.L. Tripp.

“Ardie” graduated from Westfield High School in 1950, obtained her A.A in Pre-School Education from Stephens College, MO in 1952, and in 1969 received her nursing diploma from Centre County School of Nursing, State College, PA.

After being a homemaker while her children were young, she went into a long and varied career in nursing, retiring in 1995 from the Gloucester County Sheriff’s Department where she had been a medic at the County prison for 7 years.
