January 21, 1919 - August 8, 2010

Blanche Potts, 91, beloved wife, mother and grandmother, died on August 8, 2010. Born Blanche Sokolowski on January 21, 1919, she was a seamstress during and after WWII. She married Walter Potts, former mayor of Deptford, NJ, on April 25, 1942 who predeceased her. As well as a caring and generous homemaker, she was employed as a wirewrapper for RCA and other local companies, was active in the Democratic Party and worked local elections for many years. Blanche, a founding member of Most Holy Redeemer Parish, very much enjoyed her years as a choir member. Most of all, Blanche will be remembered for her devotion to her family, especially her grandchildren whom she adored, and her kindness and generosity to her friends. Her stories, handed down to her children and grandchildren, of her youth as a farm girl and maid in eastern Pennsylvania during the Great Depression will never be forgotten. Blanche is also predeceased by her son Michael Potts, her parents, Jacob and Stella Sokolowski, her sister Genevieve Skowronek, and her brother Zigmond Sokolowski. She is survived by her children, Lawrence Potts of Deptford, NJ, and Bernice Brody of Hopewell Junction, NY, her grandchildren Jessica and Allison Brody, nephew Edward Skowronek, nieces Carol Skowronek and Arline Sidle, and great nieces and nephews.
