She was a visiting nurse responsible for taking care of her "guys and girls" in the six southern most counties of NJ under the AIDS Community Care Alternatives Programs (ACCAP). She was a dedicated nurse and was involved in all areas of interest that impacted her patients and an active member of the South Jersey Council On AIDS and Cumberland County HIV Planning Council. Caroline received the Woman of the Year Award for her dedication to individuals living with HIV/AIDS. She was also a member and active volunteer of Most Holy Redeemer Parish and served as a Eucharistic Minister, Religious Ed teacher and a member of the St. Vincent De Paul Society.
