View Dwight's Video Tribute Stoddard, Dwight Hunt suddenly on August 18, 2007 of Media, Pa. Age 60. Son of the late Herbert and Elizabeth Hunt Stoddard. Common law husband of Beth Ann Stevens. Brother of Dr. Neil, and his wife Linda and niece Rachel Stoddard of Charlestown, MD. Also survived by the Sennott, Stevens, O' Donnell families and many close friends. Born in Philadelphia, PA, Jan 5, 1947, Dwight spent some of his early childhood in Oswego, NY. His family moved to Media, PA in 1951. Dwight lived in the same house throughout his life, except for his time in the Army, while in collage, and a few years when he was working out of state. He was educated in the Media School District and graduated from Media High School in 1964. He would often say that he started at one corner of the school building and made his way around to all four corners from kindergarten to grade twelve. In high school, Dwight was a member of the National Honor Society; he was involved in Student Council and was a photographer for the yearbook. He also played football and participated in the track program. He graduated from Temple University with a Bachelor of Business Administration in 1986. As a youth, Dwight was involved in the Club Scout program, Boy Scouts, earned the title of Eagle Scout and continued into the Explorer program. He served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War. One of his assignments was at the US Embassy in Thailand. He received the National Defense Service Medal. Dwight's mom was a life time Girl Scout and worked for the Girl Scouts for many years. Liz received her 75 year pin a few years before her death in 2004. His dad, Herbert, passed away when Dwight was only 20. The family had taken many trips together across the county. Mr. and Mrs. Stoddard were very active in a number of communities including Media and other areas where they owned property. For the past 18 years Dwight has been employed with the Devereux Foundation, King of Prussia, PA. A strong supporter of the purposes of the Foundation, he was an active volunteer at many of their programs and projects. Dwight hiked the Appalachian Trail and climbed Mt. Washington while enjoying the White Mountains of New Hampshire. He was an avid card player and participated in football and baseball fantasy leagues. He was a faithful fan of the Philadelphia Eagles, Phillies and Flyers. He spent the Friday before each Super Bowl Sunday at the Wing Bowl for many years and was a former member of the Springfield Men's Golf Association. Engaged to be married September 1, 2007 to Beth

Ann Stevens, Dwight and Beth shared their lives for the last seven years, living together as husband and wife since 2002 Dwight was a great fan of the Grateful Dead and considered himself a "Deadhead". Friend to everyone, he enjoyed spending time with life-long friends and family. He loved to read, go to several movies in the same day/night, and had just gotten into solving Sudoku puzzles. He enjoyed walking and loved golf of any kind, day or night, with a group or alone.
