



Eric Domurat

June 28, 1915 - October 25, 2011

Eric Domurat, 96, died on October 25, 2011 peacefully at home in Deptford, New Jersey. He was born in Wisna, Poland on June 28, 1915.

He studied conservation and church restoration arts before being called up to the Polish Army. In 1939 he was captured and taken to a work camp in Siberia. All Polish soldiers were liberated from those work camps in 1941, after which he was sent to train in the Mideast where he attained the rank of Lieutenant. He fought as part of the Allied Forces in North Africa and then was deployed to Italy as a tank commander at the Battle of Monte Cassino. After WWII, he was responsible for repatriation of Polish families in England where he met his wife, Paula (nee Szygiel).

After his first daughter was born, he and his family emigrated to the United States. He was employed by the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades. He also worked on many conservation projects including restoration of the organ at the Trenton War Memorial Building; refurbishing the original wall murals in Trenton City Hall, and; marbleizing the front altar of St. Hedwig's Church. He and his family lived in Trenton for more than 40 years, then moved to Gloucester County.

Eric is survived by his wife, Paula; three children and their spouses, Anna and Vic Thomas, George and Laura Domurat, and Barbara and Ted Turner; three grandchildren, Matthew and Veronica Bauer-Domurat and Christopher Eric Turner; four step-grandchildren, Alycia Thomas, Tod Turner, Cindy Rich, and Wendy Williams; seven step-great-grandchildren; and his siblings Pola, Janka,

Anna, and Piotr in Poland. Eric is also survived by many nieces and nephews.

A Polish mass will be held on Saturday, October 29th at 10:30 am at the chapel at the Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa, 654 Ferry Road, Doylestown, PA 18901. Interment following service.
