Everett Mitchel Hunter, known as “Bubby”, departed this life on April 21, 2012. Age 66. He was born February 9, 1946 to the late James and Dorothy (nee Hood) Hunter in Camden NJ. He attended Deptford Township grammar schools and Woodbury High School in NJ from which he graduated class of 1965. He joined the United States Army in February 1966. He served in the Vietnam War and obtained the rank of Sergeant. He earned several medals. Two of the medals are a Medal of Good Conduct and a Vietnam Service Medal with 2 Bronze Stars.
