Francis J. Weiss, 94 of Hammonton, NJ, died peacefully at his home on March 18, 2016. He was born in Philadelphia, Pa and lived in Hammonton for 67 years. Mr. Weiss was a retiree from the Atlantic City Electric Company, where he had worked for 41 years, serving in various positions, starting as a helper and working his way up to superintendent. Mr. Weiss was an army air corps veteran of World War II. He was a past president of the B.L. England Recreation Center, was a member in the America Foreign Legion, former member of Kiwanis and the Sons of Italy. The highlight of his public service was as a member of Hammonton Town Council, when he met President Regan in 1984.
