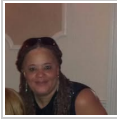

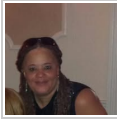

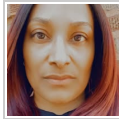

“ A Memory and a Message

I transferred to Syracuse University in the fall of 1982. A friend from high school—also an SU student—had become friendly with both Glenn and Bernard King. He was a body-builder and had been working out with them since the spring of '82. Just before the start of the semester, he called me and asked if I wanted to “go for a run” with he and Glenn.

I had never met Glenn, but of course I knew who he was. He wore the venerated number 44—enough said. I was an amateur runner at best, but the chance to meet an athlete of Glenn’s caliber, let alone run with him, was something I wasn’t going to pass up.

We met at Sky Top apartments. To me—5'4", 150 pounds—Glenn looked and carried himself like Superman. Humble, friendly, enthusiastic. He set the pace as we ran a brisk three miles to Haven Hall. We grabbed some water, and as we started the return run, Glenn looked at us and said, “I’ll see you back at the apartment, OK?”

We nodded, and within seconds he was a shrinking dot on the horizon. I couldn’t believe how fast he could run. By the time we sputtered back into the apartment, he was already showered and refreshed. I was an art student, and watching him run felt like witnessing a work of art in motion.

I asked him what he attributed his remarkable speed and agility to. He smiled and said, “You got to get right with the Lord, son!”

Superman for real.

I was deeply saddened today to learn that Glenn has gone to his Glory. My condolences to his family and to the many friends and lives he touched. His kindness, humility, and brilliance—on and off the field—left an impression on me that has lasted a lifetime.

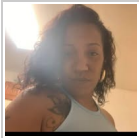

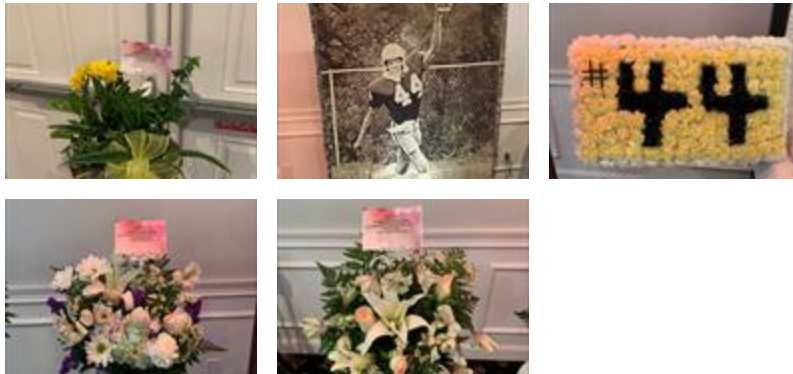

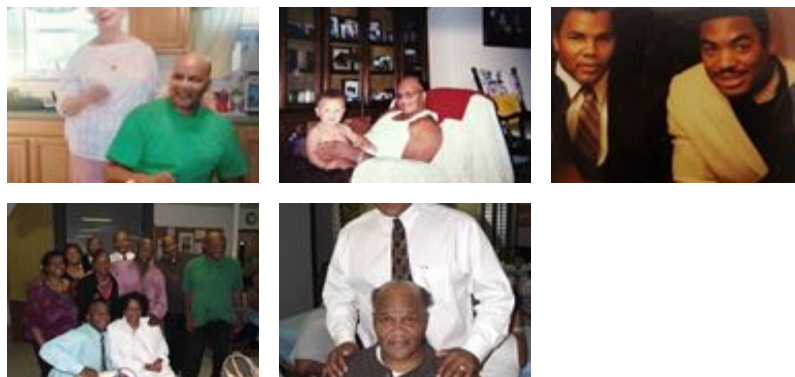
