She will be sorely missed and her memory and past efforts continue to benefit all who knew her.

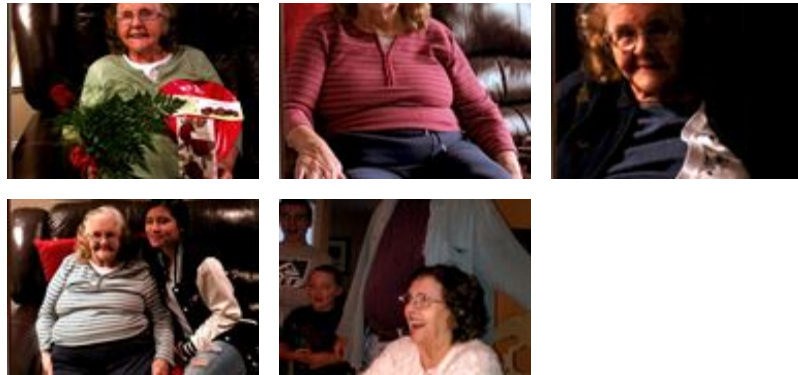
