James E. Delaney, Sr. "Spike" of Deptford passed away on January 19, 2012. He was 69 years old. Born in West Virginia the only child of James T. and Juanita (nee Talkington). He graduated from Central Catholic High School and attended West Liberty College in West Virginia. He married the love of his life Carol A. Larson in 1960. Together they raised six children. They moved to California where he worked at BF Goodrich in Long Beach from 1964-1969. He then moved to Deptford and worked at the BF Goodrich plant in Pedricktown. He retired in 2005 from Oxy Vinyls with over 35 years of service. Spike was an avid reader of science fiction and enjoyed watching the history channel. He spent many years going to Okracoke with his good friends on fishing trips. He also spent many weekends in the Poconos at Arrowhead Lakes with his family.

He was a frequent blood donor for the red cross and a member of the Racoon Creek Boat Club and the Okracoke Fishing Club from NJ.
