



## James Robert Stolz

April 21, 1932 - December 23, 2010

James Robert "Bob" Stolz, Sr., 78 of Oak Valley, Deptford, died Thursday, December 23 with his wife of 54 years, Patricia, by his side. Born in Philadelphia, he was a graduate of Bartram High School. In high school he began his long tradition of volunteerism at Treasure Island Boy Scout Camp on the Delaware River where he served as camp counselor. He enlisted in the US Navy and served during the Korean War. Mr. Stolz then became an electronics apprentice at the Philadelphia Navy Yard and was an electronics systems mechanic for 25 years. After his retirement from the Philadelphia Navy Yard, he was a consultant for Scientific Management Associates in Westville.

Bob and Pat were among the very first residents of Oak Valley, moving in one week after their wedding in August, 1956. He was a charter member of the Oak Valley Fire Department and served in many capacities including president, lieutenant, assistant chief, and treasurer. He was predeceased by his parents, John Ralph and Elizabeth; his son, Christopher; and his brothers, John Ralph, Jr. and William.

In addition to his wife Patricia, he is survived by his son, James Robert, Jr. and his wife, Alice and his daughter Betty Garger and her husband, Andy and grandchildren; Jennifer Stolz, Amanda Garger, Josh Stolz, Dylan Stolz, Drew Garger, and Richie Stolz.
