View John's Video Tribute John J. Marccone, age 52, of Woodbury, went quietly home to his Lord on February 7, 2006 after a courageous battle with diabetes and other illnesses. He was a heart transplant survivor for close to eight years. At his bedside were his beloved daughters, Jessica Anne Lightfoot (Garry) of Elk Township, Cassandra Marie and Melanie Jo of Pitman. He is also survived by sisters Marie Brasberger (Joseph) of Woodbury Hts., Loretta Stech (David) of Collingswood and brother Jerry of West Deptford, son-in-law Garry Lightfoot and grandsons Pierce John and Luke James and numerous nieces and nephews. John is pre-deceased by his mother and father, Josephine and Joseph Marccone of Woodbury Heights. A former owner of Evergreen Lumber in Woodbury Hts., he became an entrepreneur who owned and operated an Italian Delicatessen in Rockland, Maine from 1979-84. He returned to NJ in 1984 and was a sales and finance manager for various car dealerships in the Pa., NJ and Florida areas. John is remembered for his gentle spirit, his sense of humor, being a self-proclaimed sun worshiper, a life long friendship with Italian cuisine, and above all, his love of family and devotion to friends. Despite his long-term illness, John always remembered birthdays and holidays by ensuring all received gifts of love. His presence will remain forever in the hearts of all who knew him.
