Julia Celeste Wroten was born to Robert and Annie Bell Ford on March 3, 1912 and was one of eight children. Julia was born in Forest, Virginia and lived in Philadelphia, most of her years, and later moved to Deptford, New Jersey until her death. When growing up, she attended Armstrong Elementary and Dumbar High School. On December 19, 1941, Julia was united in holy matrimony to James B. Wroten Jr. They were blessed with one son, James and three daughters; Yvonne, Marilyn, and Darlene. Julia was a person, who through out her life loved to be among family. She was a loving Mother and devoted wife, and with her quiet spirit, brought much joy to all. As a mother, she loved children and had an open door policy to the neighborhood children, allowing them to feel right at home. Julia was very much involved in her children's education, and community functions. She was an active and devoted member of both the Mount Carmel Baptist Church and Grace Temple Baptist Church. She was one who never complained, and when asked how she was feeling, she would always say, "I'm fine". The most memorable times with Julia included, the family outings, sitting in the kitchen watching her as she prepared meals for the family, and her loving values taught through her tough love techniques. Julia leaves to cherish her; four children, one daughter-in-law, two son-in-laws, eleven grandchildren, twenty-one great-grandchildren and eight great-great grandchildren.
