Louis E. Nicastro “Gi-Gie” on February 2, 2018 of Cherry Hill, NJ. Age 93. Husband for 68 ½ years of devoted wife Nancy (nee Spera). Father of David Nicastro (Treacey) of Mullica Hill, Mark Nicastro (Maddy) of Mt. Laurel and the late Carlo Nicastro (Paula) of Medford and the late infant daughter Ruth. Grandfather of Matthew, Kristine, Elizabeth, Louis, Kyle and Taylor. Great-grandfather of Alyssa, Olivia, Harrison David and Connor.

Gi-Gie was a WWII Navy Veteran, an Athlete, Educator, Track Coach and Chief Starter at Penn Relays for 37 years and starter at the 1984 Olympics. He was inducted into Penn Relays Wall of Fame on April 6, 2003 as a member of the Northeast High School 1941 record breaking America Championship 2-mile relay team. At NE, he won the Philadelphia 880 championship which brought several scholarship offers which were not accepted to enlist in the U.S. Navy.

Three years coaching at Roman Catholic High School he won three Catholic track championships as well as the National Catholic Championship. In 1958 the 2-mile relay team, anchored by nephew, Pasquale, set National (world best) records in winning the National indoor 2-mile relay championship. Also set Penn Relays record in winning the American Championship.

Three years as St. Joseph's coach he won two track and two cross-country

championships. In 1965 he won the ICAAAA college x-country championship. Moving to U of P to coach with world renowned Irv Mondenschein as sprint & hurdles coach, his 400 meter hurdler won the Penn Relays American Championship and also selected as an NCAA All-American.

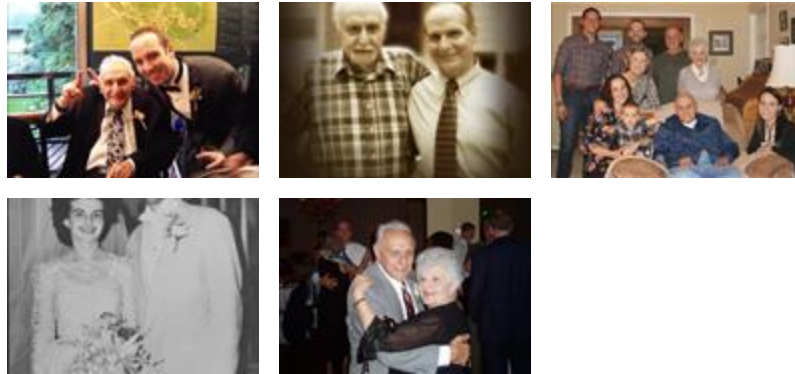
