She worked at Grants, Berlin Mart, Dunkin Donuts and was a member of the Democrat Club and was 1st District Committeewoman. She was an avid bowler at Sunset Lanes in Deptford, loved travelling, played at the Atlantic City Casino’s “known as Lucky Peg”, played Pokeno with the members of Almolind Homes, ten year resident of Nancy Ellis Apartments and

played Bingo frequently. She will be dearly missed by all.
