Marilyn "Moni" Beth Gill (née Myers) passed suddenly on July 11th, 2025, of Cape May Court House/Wenonah, NJ, and Marathon, FL. Born in Philadelphia on January 30, 1947.

Predeceased by her husband of 50 years, Ron "Robalo" Gill.
