Mary Ann Mercer Beal (85) of Moorestown, NJ passed away peacefully at her residence in Woodbury on Wednesday February 14, 2024. She is survived by her husband of 54 years William David Beal, her two children Christy Ann Beal Engel (John) and David Thomas Beal (Sierra) and three grandchildren Niobe Engel, Cassiopeia Beal, and Orion Beal. Mary Ann is predeceased by her brothers William Mercer and Tom Mercer. And her parents Tom Mercer and Mary “Mayme” Vickroy Mercer.

Mary Ann was born in Cincinnati in 1938. Raised in the Price Hill district she went on to study at Ohio University, earning a Master’s Degree in Education from Miami University of Ohio. From there she was a teacher, teaching 1st grade in rural Piqua, Ohio.

Through mutual friends she met the love of her life W. David Beal. Married in 1969, they honeymooned in San Francisco and initially settled in Chicago. Mary Ann followed her new husband as he worked in different cities over the years, eventually taking a position in Philadelphia. While living in Moorestown, Mary Ann raised her own two children and delighted in welcoming no fewer than 10 exchange students into her home all while still being a second Mom to dozens of other children over the years. Mary Ann continued to teach, working as a substitute, sometimes for long periods at Westfield Friends School.

A quilter, needlepointer, and genealogist, Mary Ann's craft room or office always had several projects going. She pursued her genealogy all the way back to Europe while visiting ancestral towns and amassed an extensive database of the family history. An avid reader Mary Ann kept an extensive library. She had a special interest in Harry Potter and Lord of the Rings. Rereading and researching those stories became a favorite pastime.

Mary Ann was a devoted grandmother. Even with grandchildren on both coasts she could always be counted on for support and bragged about every milestone. A lover of history, she believed and lived the motto "family can be forever".

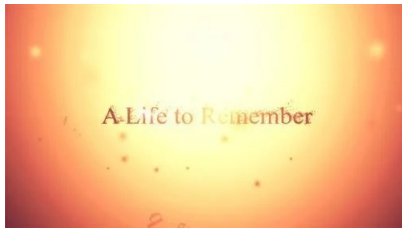

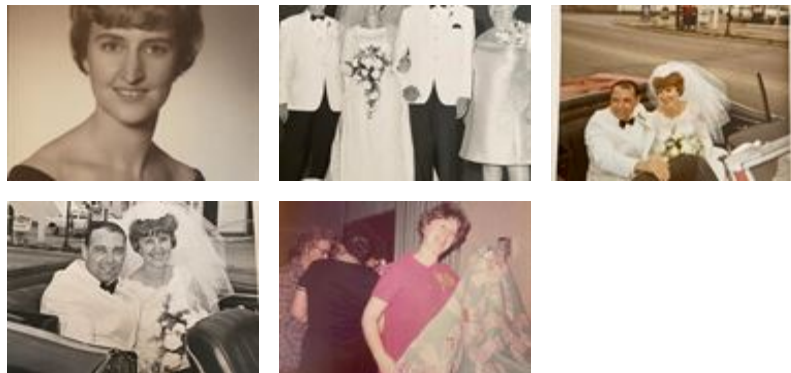
