From the age of twelve, Meto was an award winning, internationally renowned acrobat with Troupe Romanov, performing feats not since replicated. He toured extensively in Europe and the center ring of Ringling Brothers from 1968 to 80. Winner of the world circus festival in 1981, Meto later retired from performing and settled in National Park. He became a fine carpenter leaving beautiful craftsmanship of woodworking and stained glass as mementos for his children. Meto was a fun loving person with many dear friends. In leaving this world he would like all of his acquaintances to know if he ever had done anything to offend anyone, it was unintentional.
