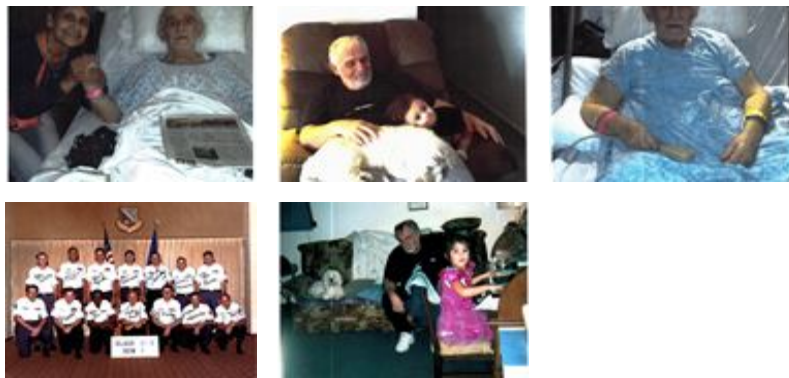

Dad you had the will to survive the worse.

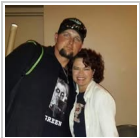
Rehab will not be fun or short, but necessary and I know you can do it!

Please don't give up, we LOVE you soo much!!

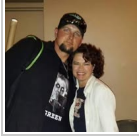
