Raymond Lee “Ramie” Winter, 72, of Deptford, New Jersey, passed away peacefully at his home on Monday, November 3, 2025, surrounded by his loving family after a long and courageous battle with lymphoma. 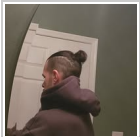

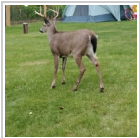
