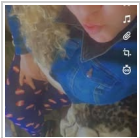

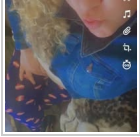

Rappo and Ryan Family .RIP Bobby 🙏🙏🙏

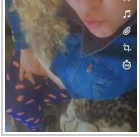
