Robert Lorenzo Townes, Jr. was born on January 27, 1954, in Camden, New Jersey, to the late Robert L. Townes, Sr. and Ethel Townes. Robert departed this life on Monday, August 4, 2025.

Robert lived his life based on a love for the Lord, keen business acumen, a stellar work ethic, and a heart for service.

Robert was educated in the Pennsauken Township Public School system and graduated from Pennsauken High School. Always gifted at working with his hands, he attended Burlington County College in Mount Laurel, New Jersey, where he majored in residential wiring. He later developed his love for business at John Tyler Community College in Chesterfield, Virginia, where he majored in accounting and was on the Dean’s List.

Robert nurtured his relationship with Christ from an early age. As a child, he attended St. John Baptist Church in Camden, New Jersey. He later joined Broad Rock Baptist Church in Richmond, Virginia, in 1991. Continuing to seek Godly fellowship wherever he went, Robert also attended Bethlehem Baptist Church in Richmond, Virginia, where he sang in the men’s choir. He also

attended Faith Landmark Ministries in Richmond, Virginia. Whenever he traveled, he always made a point to visit a church in the community.

He was committed to his family. In January 1973, he married Caretha D. Grant. From this union were born three children, LaKeisha Shanique, Nytia Shanine, and Robert Lorenzo III.

Focused on seeking opportunities for growth and advancement, Robert moved his family to Michigan in 1977 and became an integral part of developing a Bake-A-Teria store in his area. He took the family along for many deliveries, and they all enjoyed the freshly baked donuts! In 1983, Robert confidently relocated his family to Virginia where he seized a growth opportunity with the United States Postal Service. This opportunity developed into a long-term career where Robert faithfully maintained employment until 2013, retiring with 30 years of service. During his employment, Robert received numerous accolades for his exceptional customer service and attention to detail. Following his retirement, Robert's entrepreneurial spirit really took shape. Over the years, he created several businesses and enjoyed being self-employed. In 2018, Robert started new career ventures with Estes Express Lines and the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority. He was continually honored for his excellent work at both locations. Robert was always excited to learn new skills and broaden his areas of expertise. But even more exciting for him was the chance to encourage and inspire everyone that he encountered.

Robert would often say he had his mother's heart - meaning he possessed a love and desire to sacrificially serve others. He felt privileged to be a blessing in his community. Robert volunteered at St. Mary's Hospital – Ronald McDonald House where he served snacks to the families, distributed toys to the children, and always offered an encouraging word to those in attendance. He also purchased food, gathered volunteers, and organized events to feed

the homeless on a continual basis. He coordinated Christmas events for senior housing residents and took clothes and other needed items to local homeless shelters. For Robert, giving was more than a pastime. It was a way of life.

He gave of his time, talent, and treasure. Throughout his life Robert always took the time to share practical knowledge, words of wisdom, and his faith with others. He was exceptional with finances and business and was always willing to teach others how to succeed. Additionally, he was known for his kindness, support, encouragement, and mentorship. He was a caring father to his children and served as a father figure to many.

Robert loved to write, dance, and travel. He was blessed to visit numerous states and travel abroad to visit England, France, and many other destinations.

Robert was blessed to live a good life. His life was filled with joy, love, contentment, peace, happiness, and laughter. He enjoyed sowing into his children, spending time with and celebrating his grandchildren, and encouraging those he encountered to be kind, enjoy life, and be grateful. He loved reading and quoting God's Word. One of his favorite phrases that showed his heart of gratitude was based on Psalm 23:5-6, "my cup runneth over."
