Sandra Lee Mellor “Sandy” went home to be with the Lord on October 3, 2011. Age 62. Sandy was the kindest person to everyone. Her most beloved gift in life was her family. She was born in Philadelphia to Arthur and Agnes Cramer and raised in Barrington, NJ. She graduated Haddon Heights HS in 1967 and in September of the same year met her future husband Frank at Dancette Ballroom in Oaklyn, NJ. They were married on October 26, 1968. She first worked at a knitting yarn factory in Cherry Hill until becoming a homemaker after her first child Kim was born. She had four more children, Danielle, Frankie, Christopher and Matthew. She took care of all her children until 1988 when she went to work for the Picture Frame Store in Deptford. In 1989, she worked at Around the World Christmas Store in the Deptford Mall. She also worked at Wick’s & Sticks for ten years at the Deptford Mall and Gertrude Hawk Chocolates as a retail store manager at various locations over the next ten years until she was stricken with esophageal cancer. She fought a courageous battle with the disease until the very end. Sandy cherished family, friends, her home, and her chocolate store.

Sandy is survived by her husband Frank L. Mellor of Deptford. She is the mother of Kim Mellor (Bill) of Cherry Hill, Danielle Mellor of Philadelphia, Frank A.
