Shirley A. DeVillasanta (nee Pisieczko) of Deptford, NJ passed away on April 29, 2021 at the age of 86. Shirley was born in Philadelphia, PA to John and Marguerite Pisieczko. 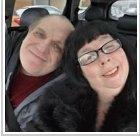

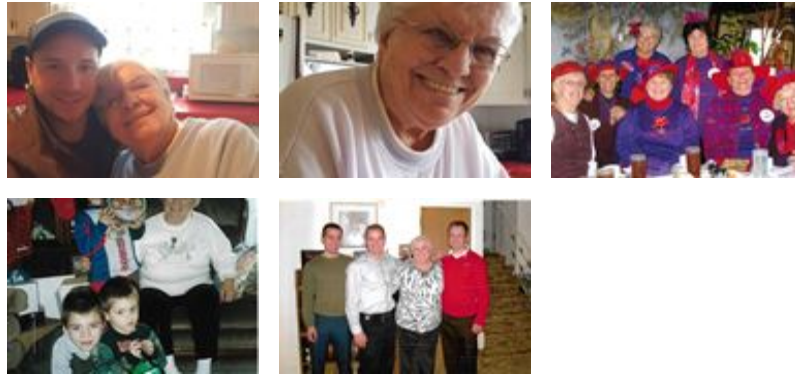
