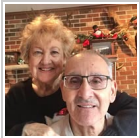

Don't worry, I'll take care of John like you always reminded me to. :)

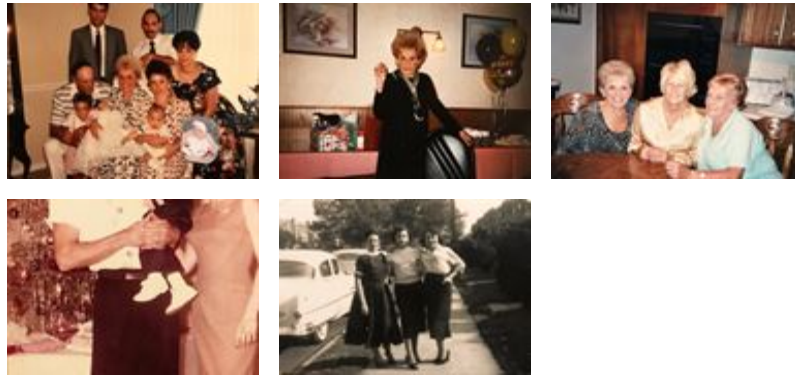
The only small comfort I have is that I know you are at peace and you will continue to protect us all. Until we meet again someday, friend.
