



## Theron H. Turner, Sr.

May 18, 1947 - January 12, 2024

Theron H. Turner, Sr. "Ted" (USCG ret.) passed away peacefully at his home on Friday, January 12, 2024. He was diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease and fought a courageous battle with grit and determination. He was born in Albany, New York in May 1947.

He was the son of George L. Brown and Susanne Chandler Hoyt, brother to Geoff Turner (d. 2019). Ted entered the U.S. Coast Guard in the 1960s and retired as a Chief Warrant Officer after 20 years of distinguished service which included being stationed in places like Michigan, Hawaii, Arizona, Guam and Washington, D.C. He served aboard and was a plank owner of the USCGC Jarvis WHEC-725. After the Coast Guard, Ted was the founder and president of his own software development and consulting business which he ran for 30 years. He was an avid golfer and Philadelphia Phillies fan.

Ted is survived by his loving wife of 35 years, Barbara (nee Domurat) ; his beloved children, Tod (Cindy), Cynthia Rich, Wendy (Ben) Stahl, and Chris. Also surviving are 7 amazing grandchildren (Amanda, Stephanie, Elaine, Charlie, Cynthia Jean, Samantha, Mark); one energetic great-grandson (Hayden); and many loved nieces and nephews.

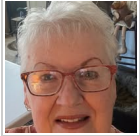
