Tommy coached for Deptford's Little League for 15 years, was President of Deptford Midget Football for 13 years, a member of Deptford's Volunteer Hall of Fame, and a lifetime member of Deptford's Elks Lodge 2708. He was very involved with his community. Growing up, he was an MHR starting point guard for their basketball team and was the highest scoring player in the school's history for three years. As a proud Spartan, he was starting defensive end for Deptford High School football for two years. Tommy enjoyed gardening and earned a 4th degree black belt in Tang Soo Do martial arts.
