Walter C. List, Jr. "Walt" passed away peacefully on March 12, 2019 in his home in Deptford at age 84. He is survived by his longtime companion Delores "Dee" Grant. Loving father of Kathleen Mulholland of Swedesboro, Patricia Salter of Stratford and Linda Turk and her husband Jim of Mullica Hill. Beloved brother of Doris Redick and her husband Bill of Dover, DE. Devoted grandfather of Erin Mulholland, Nichole Salter, Jimmy Salter and Jordyn Turk.

Walt was an original resident of Oak Valley and was the President of the Oak Valley Lake Association, President of the Community Association, member and past President of Deptford Rotary. He worked at General Electric in the space program until 1970 when he started Adams Technical Maintenance, a smoke and fire restoration company in Woodbury Hts. He was owner and operator until 1986 when he retired at age 50. He continued to work as a carpenter, maintenance man, and handyman.

He purchased a "home on the water" in Wildwood in 1988 which became soon become known as "Walt's Place". A favorite pastime down the shore was driving his boat to the Lobster House. One of his favorite places at home included Nipper's Pub. Throughout his life, Walt enjoyed lots of laughs, telling stories and making memories for other people.
