Interment Eglington Cemetery, Clarksboro.

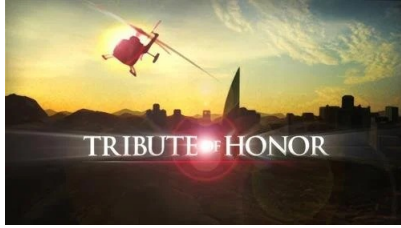
