Bill served in the Korean War Combat Engineers 24th Division achieving the rank of Staff Sergeant upon his discharge. He lived in Glenolden, PA briefly before moving to Deptford where he lived for 46 years. Bill was a steel foundry pattern maker for Westinghouse Electric Turbine Systems Division in Lester, PA starting as an apprentice in 1948 and became the pattern maker supervisor. As business changed Bill was the supervisor at various times of the maintenance, pipefitters, and lastly shipping department upon the plant's closing in 1987. Bill retired with 39 years service and loved every minute of it. "Westinghouse stories" were often told well after retirement.

Summer vacations were usually spent in North Wildwood crabbing off the dock or fishing in the back bay. Bill was the true definition of a family man just happy to go to work and provide for his family. He loved to build and fix things in his basement shop. He was frequently seen with Millie at the sports events of his grandchildren.

He will be greatly missed by his family.
