Rest in peace, Country Boy, Love your City girl

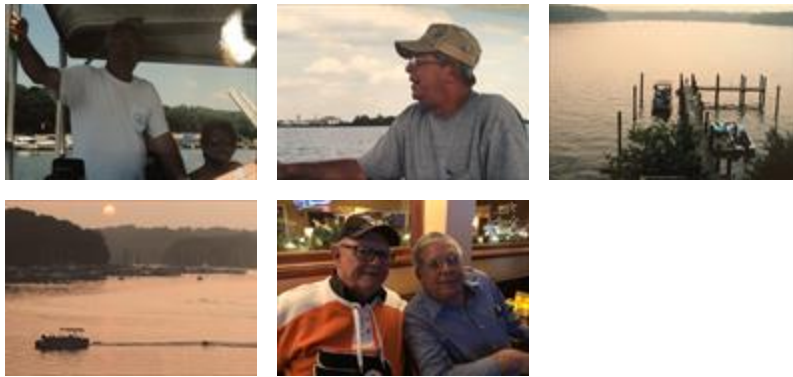
